The Educational Foundation is a community-based organization whose purpose is to enhance and enrich the educational program for the benefit of all students within the Liberty Union High School District.

ACTIVITIES OF THE FOUNDATION

The Educational Foundation participates in a variety of fundraising activities that provide the means to make a positive impact in the classroom and

Through a competitive process, the Foundation provides grants to teachers for innovative educational programs.

The Foundation also annually awards

scholarships to students at Liberty, Freedom, Heritage, La Paloma and Independence high schools.



FUNDRAISING PROGRESS AND GOALS

To date, the Foundation has raised well over \$130,000 and has awarded 87 grants to teachers totaling almost \$98,000, as well as awarding multiple annual scholarships to students at all five district high schools. The Foundation has set a fundraising goal of \$500,000 which would enable grants and scholarships to be awarded on the basis of interest earned by its principal investment.
